HOW TO DETAIL YOUR CAR

TOOLS OF THE TRADE

- Vacuum cleaner
- Variety of rags
- Various sizes of small brushes
- Plastic spray bottles

CONTINUED

- Canned air (used on the computer keyboards)
- Upsholstery or leather cleaner
- Carpet stain cleaner all-purpose cleaner
- Surface protector for vinyl/leather surfaces

DETAILING THE INTERIOR

- Carpets vacuum and remove stains
- Upholstery vacuum and remove stains
- Door jams clean metal and plastic
- Door interiors clean surfaces and crevices

CONTINUED

- Inside windows wipe clean, then dry
- Steering wheel and column dust, dry, and used surface protectant
- Dashboard clean with small brushes
- Center console use details tools and a thick cloth

DETAILING THE EXTERIOR

- Start with the wheels no detergent in solution
- Change water and add car wash soap
- Wash car with clean rags and soapy solution
- If a rag becomes dirty, use a clean one
- Rinse everything well with clean water

CONTINUED

- To dry the car, use only a chamois or cotton cloth
- Blow away standing water with a hair dryer
- Wax the car
- After the wax dries, wipe away with a brush
- Use a newspaper to clean the windows and mirrors

This may seem like a lot of work, but it's a good idea to detail your car every few months. This will keep your car looking nice for many years.

Plus, who doesn't love driving around in a fresh, spotless vehicle?
